Indianapolis, Ind. – On the evening of March 14, 2024, a line of severe storms moved through Winchester, IN. We are heartbroken for the devastation across the Winchester community. Our foremost concern is the safety and well-being of our employees and customers who have been affected by this tragic event.

The Goodwill Store located at 911 E. Greenville Pike that opened in August of 2023, sustained major damage and will be temporarily closed. We are working to ensure all employees who were present in the store at that time are accounted for and safe; and will offer support and services to those employees affected while the store is temporarily closed.

We want to assure our loyal customers and the community that we are committed to rebuilding and coming back stronger. We understand the importance of our services and the role we play in our community, and we are determined to restore operations as soon as it is safe and feasible to do so.

We would also like to express our sincere thanks to local emergency services for their swift response, tireless efforts and bravery. We are proud to be a vital part of the Winchester community and will do what is needed to help as we recover from the storms.
